Based on the above rationale, the FHWA has determined that when the Blue Book is used to calculate equipment rental costs for periods of less than a month, the most equitable approach is to utilize an hourly rate developed by dividing the Blue Book monthly equipment rental rate by 176.

Equipment Rental Rates - Contract Administration ...

Monthly rental rates vary from 2% to 5% of the purchase price of the equipment depending on the anticipated life of the equipment and its wearing parts. Weekly rental rates are about 1/3 the monthly rates, and daily rental rates are about 1/3 the weekly rate. Rental rates can also be treated as reimbursement costs for contractor-owned
