### Set the resolution manually on XP - Windows Forum - Spiceworks

If you're aiming to create a custom QHD resolution (2560 x 1440), type 2560 in Horizontal Pixels and 1440 in Desired Lines, or if you're aiming for 4K resolution, type 3840 in Horizontal Pixels and 2160 in Desired Lines . You can also choose a lower resolution than the native resolution of your display, if you desire.
